Pharmacy - Cllr. Galvez's opinion is that there will not be a pharmacy on Camposol until the Centro de Salud is completed.

I.B.I. Tax - An explanation of what the revenue from this tax is spent on is given.

Plans - Cllr Galvez wishes to remind everyone that there are many plans which have been passed awaiting collection in the Planning Office, and that work done is still not legal without them.

Bus route through Camposol - Delay due to decision pending.

Matters Arising:

- Correos: The committee is to seek a meeting with Correos. Brian will ask Cllr Galvez to arrange it. The subject of available land for post rooms will be again discussed at the next Masa meeting.

- Road system around B commercial: To be discussed further at next meeting between Brian and Cllr. Galvez; To be raised again at next meeting with our lawyer, and to seek a meeting with Cllr. responsible for Roads in Ayuntamiento.

- Ecoparque: We will try to get leaflets put into English and information will be in next months Courier.

- Car Boot sale: Was closed down for many reasons, and will need the consent of the Cllr for Commerce to re-open, and be strictly monitored.
